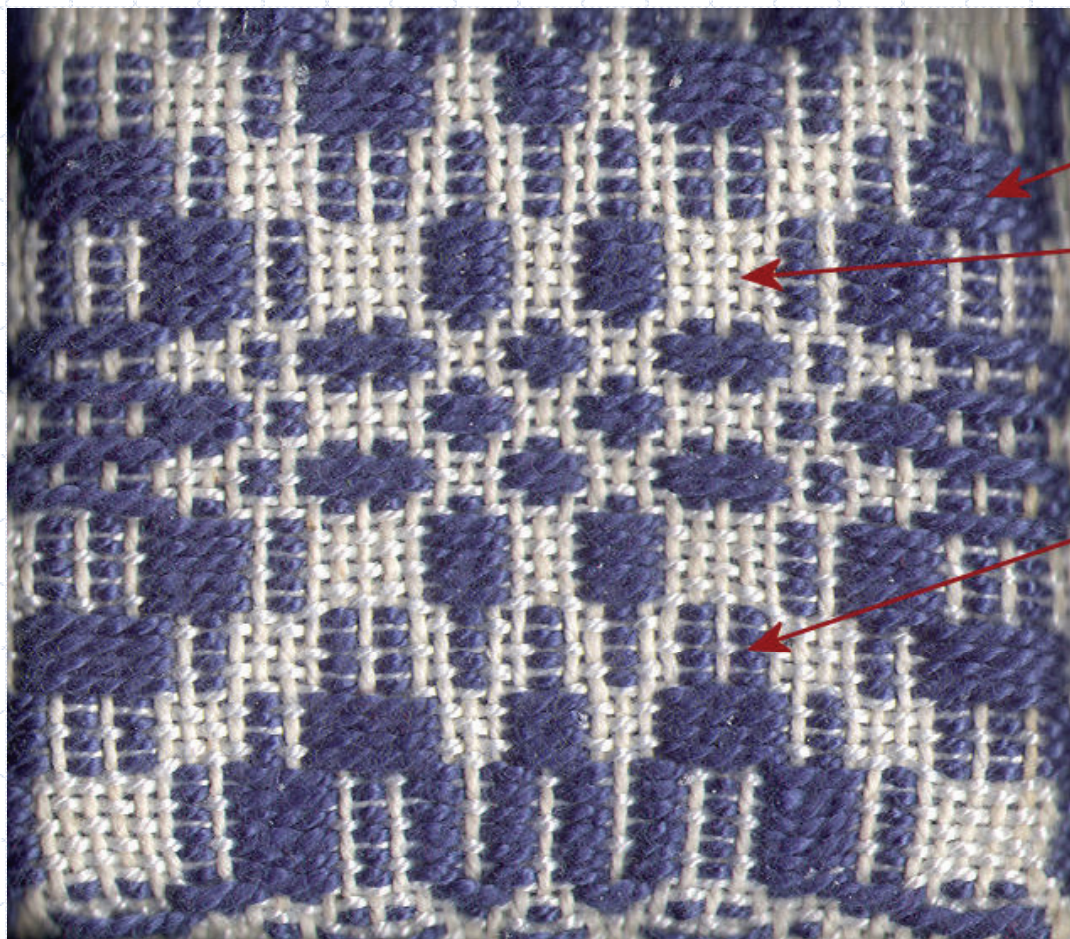


Overshot

- ◆ 1. 4-blocks on 4-shaft looms
- ◆ 2. Threading—odd/even sequence
- ◆ 3. Woven—block order—with tabby
- ◆ 4. A block weave, not a unit weave
- ◆ 5. Float length must be considered

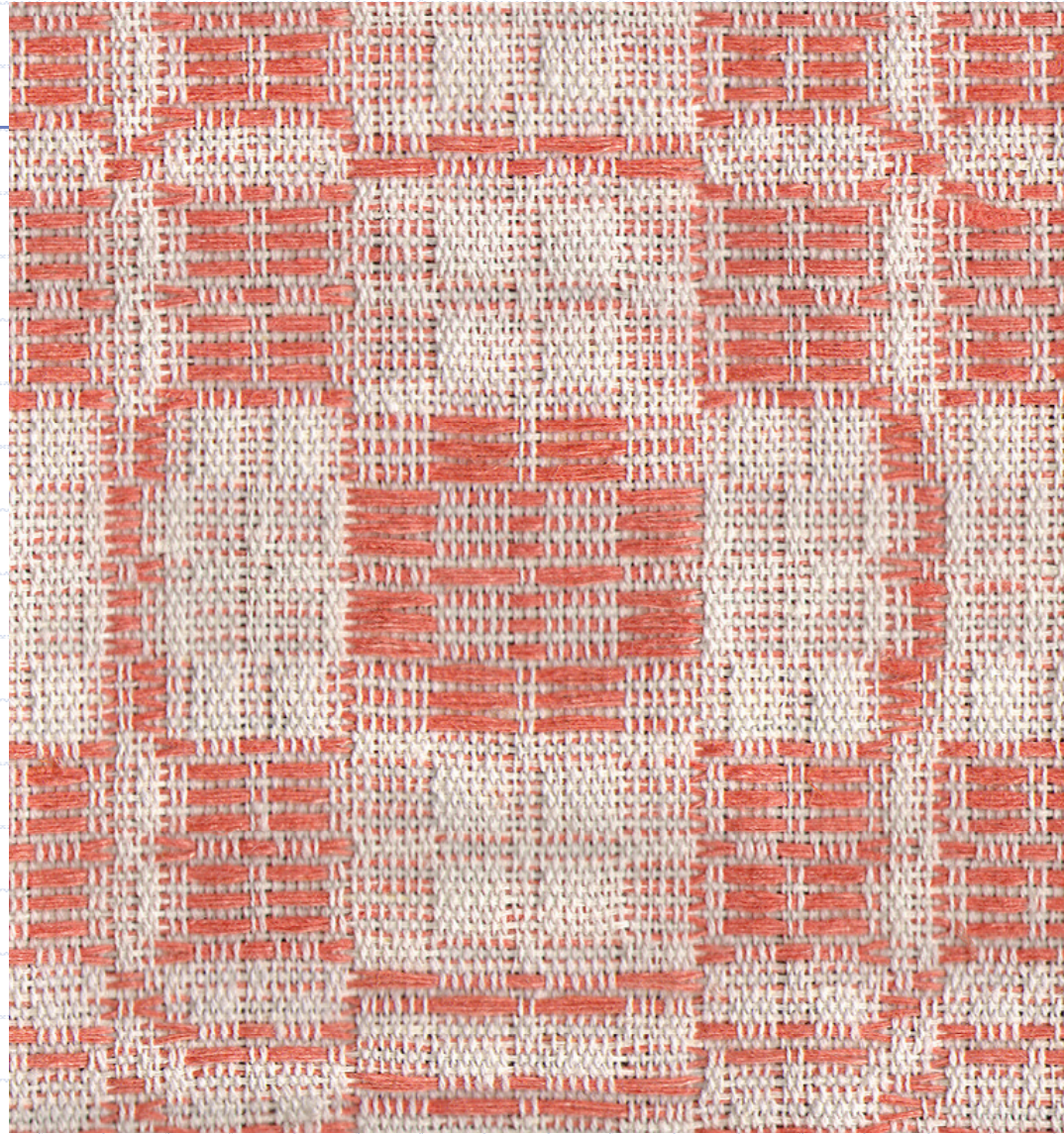

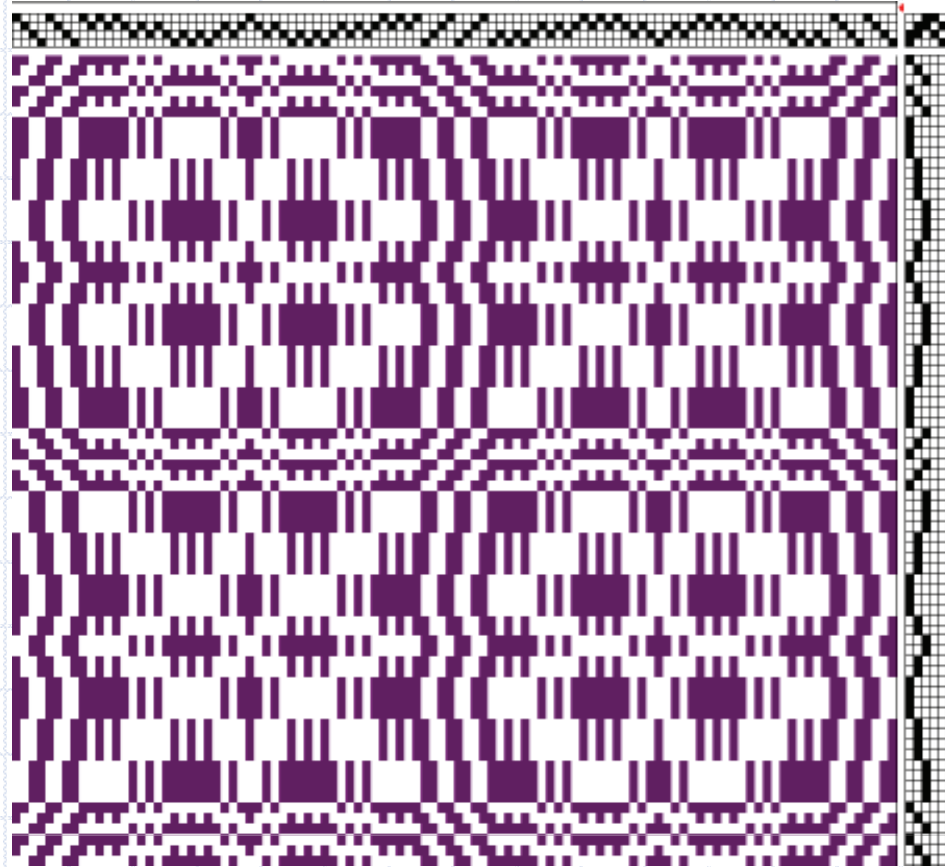
Halftones

4-shaft overshot — threads that look different



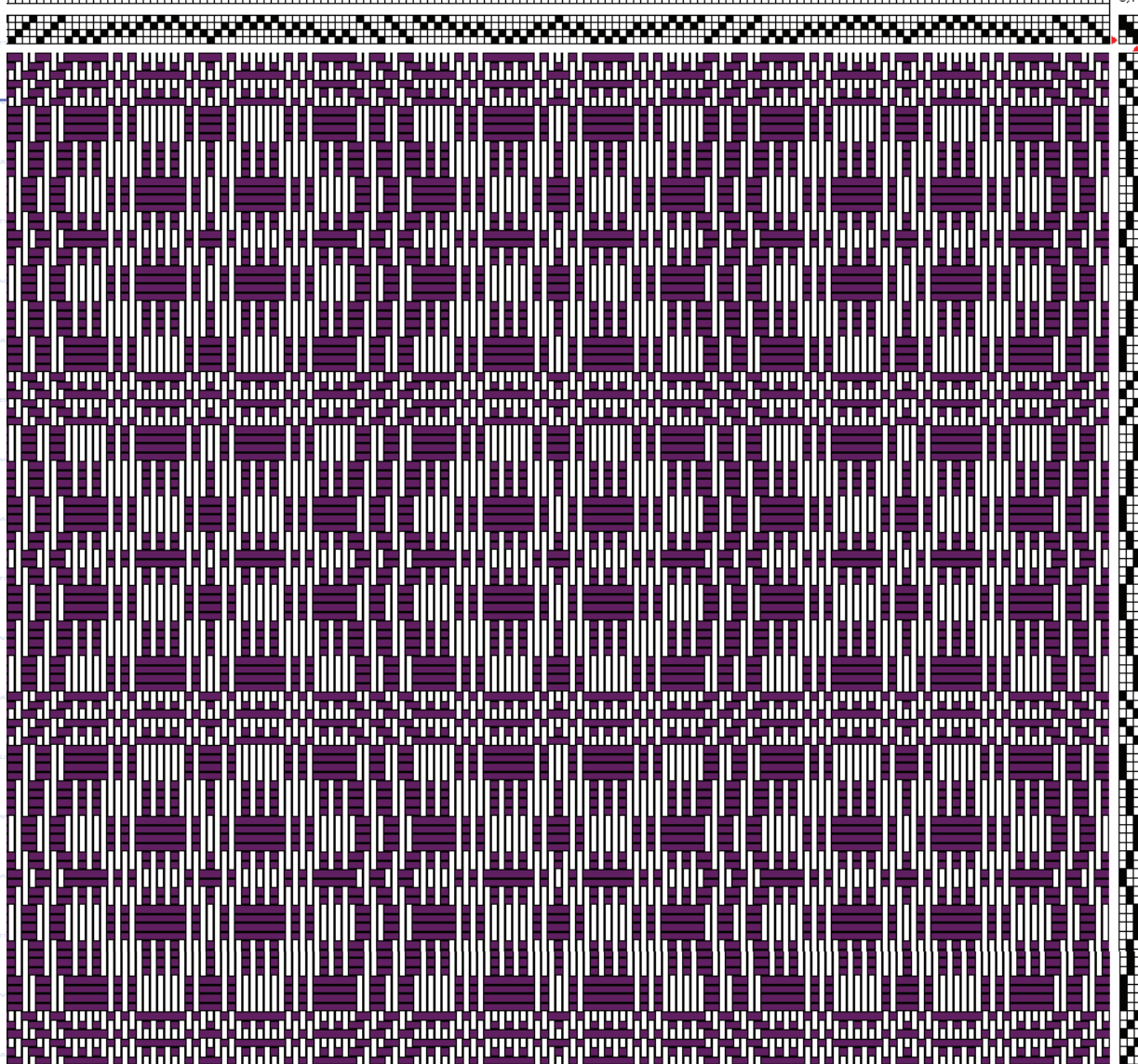

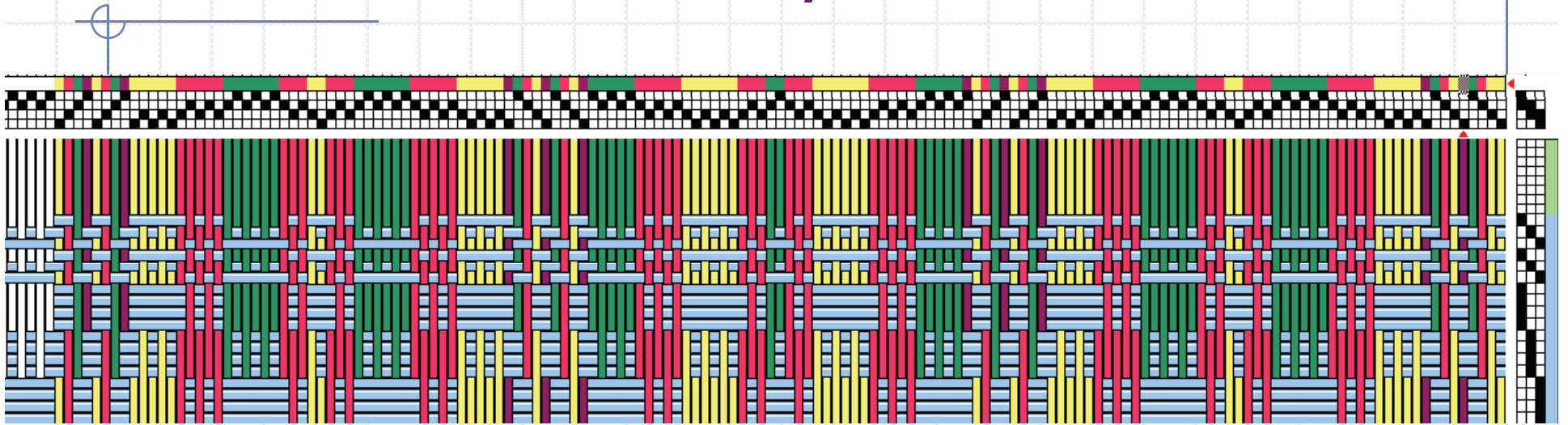


Wrap Tie-ups

(Draft is actually only 3-blocks)

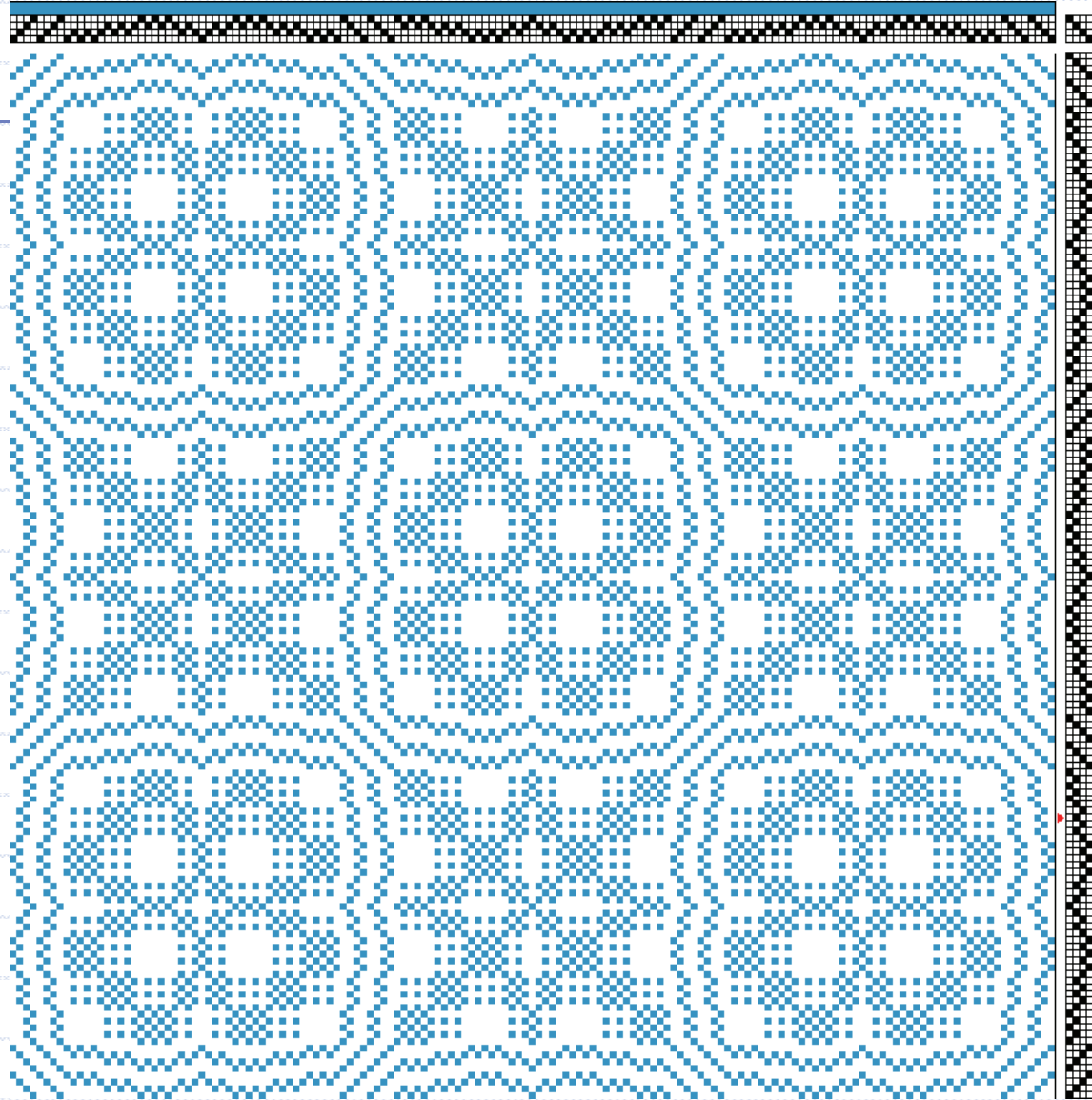


Color the draft or circle the blocks to identify blocks

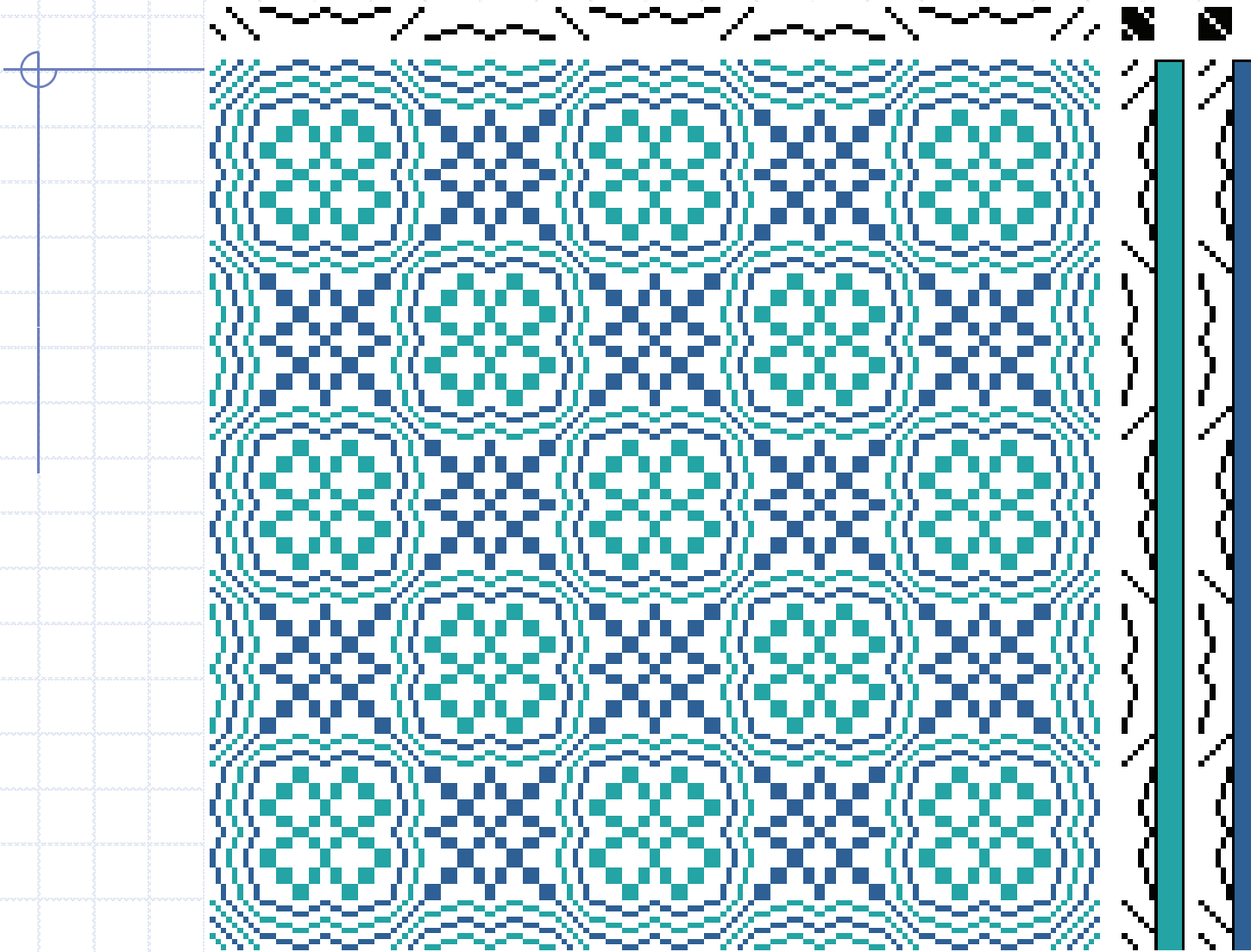


Draft can be made larger or smaller by adding or subtracting pairs of ends in a block.

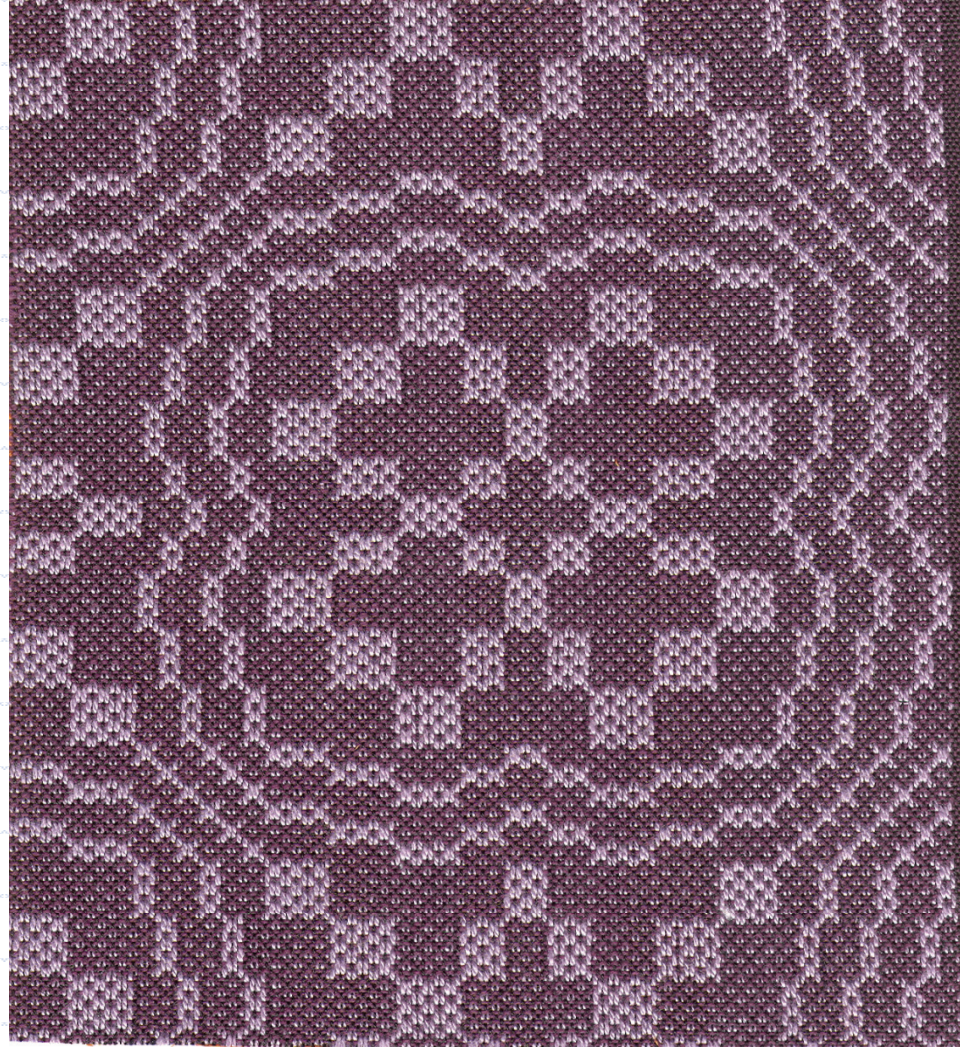
Using the draft for 4-block Double Weave on 4-shafts

To Design Pine Trees
Blocks are combined, so it cannot be done in overshoot
